MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR CAMP LEADERS

Involvement in the camp ministry of the United Church requires allegiance to a set of beliefs and guidelines. These are constructed on the teachings of the United Church based on the teachings of the scriptures as well as our understanding of the camp ministry.

1. My sole guide in faith and practice shall be the divine inspiration and authority of the Bible.
2. As members of the Church I believe...
 - In one God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
 - In Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord.
3. I believe that justification of the unsaved is by faith in Jesus Christ and His atoning blood alone and that such justification is a mercy gift of God, not by the works of any person (Romans 3: 2 1-26).
4. As a Christian my life and conduct should be based on the principle of Christ-like love.
5. As a leader I **promise** to:
 - **Provide mature spiritual oversight to all campers.**
 - **Be sensitive to the needs and concerns of the campers.**
 - **Seek to engender a feeling of Christian family fellowship at the camp.**
 - **Obey the rules of camp myself even as I seek to persuade others to do the same.**
 - **Perform the responsibilities assigned to me by the leadership of the camp.**
 - **Demonstrate respect to all who are the leaders of the camp.**
