Guidelines for congregations when Covid-19 is present

- Anyone with cold or flu-like symptoms MUST stay at home until asymptomatic (no symptoms)
- If a congregant tests positive for Covid-19, the entire family should stay at home for 14 days whether they have symptoms or not
- Where persons are identified to be having cold or flu-like symptoms <u>at</u> <u>church</u>, they MUST go home and seek medical attention immediately
- Conduct thorough cleaning of frequently trafficked or touched areas with bleach, soap and 70% alcohol where necessary
- If you are in doubt about closure of the congregation, contact your local health authority who will determine if closure is necessary
- Continue to carry out thorough cleaning/ disinfecting of sanctuary before and after every worship service or gathering

Continue to uphold infection prevention protocols including:

- 1. Temperature Checks Before Entering the Sanctuary or Place of Worship
- 2. Wearing of face mask & wearing it properly
- 3. Hand Sanitization
- 4. Social Distancing

Let us continue to educate our congregants about the Covid-19 Risk Management and Infection Prevention protocols in both nations.

Continue to provide applicable pastoral care and support for our vulnerable sisters and brothers, and those among us who may become infected with the Coronavirus (Covid-19).
